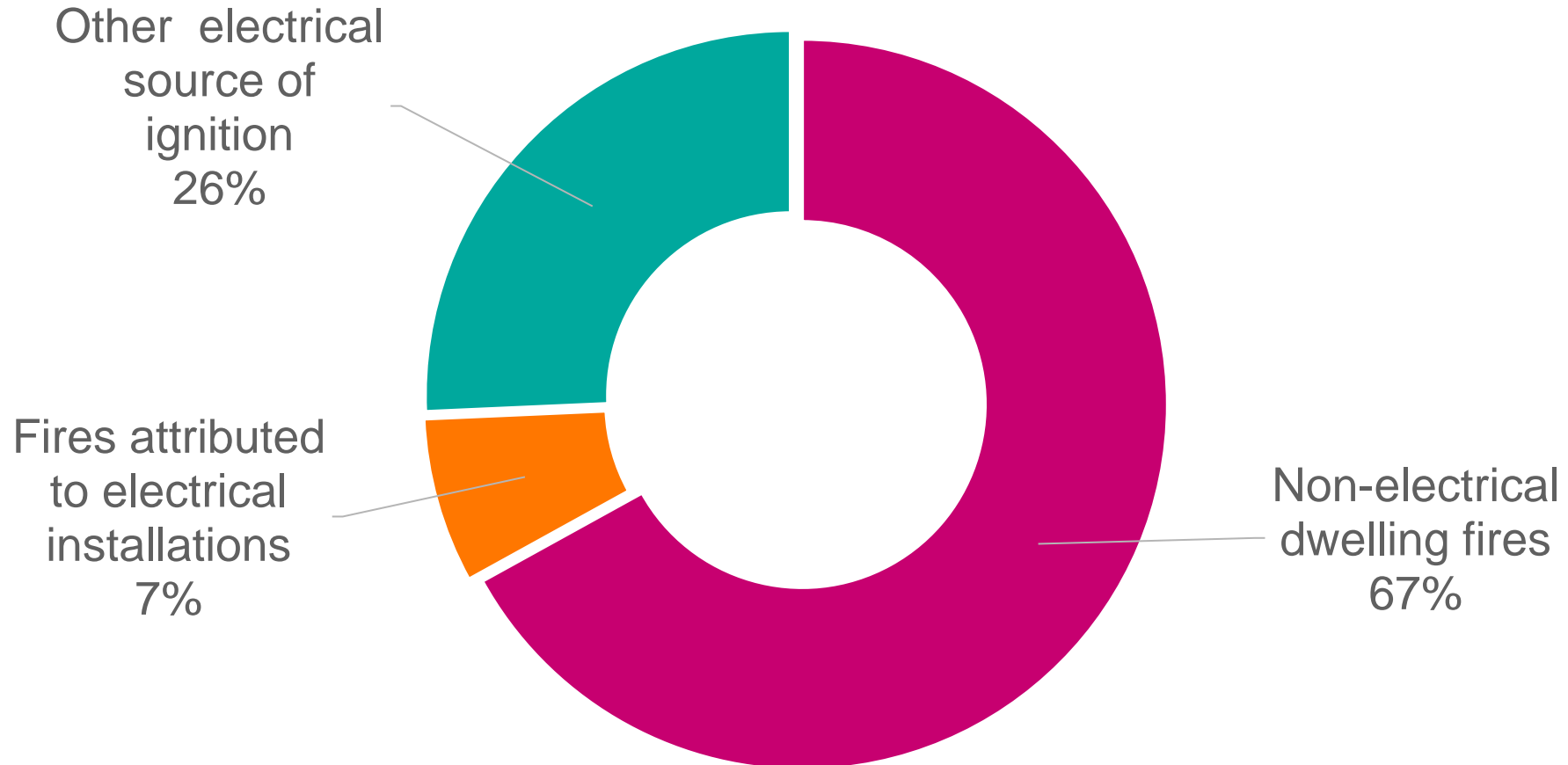

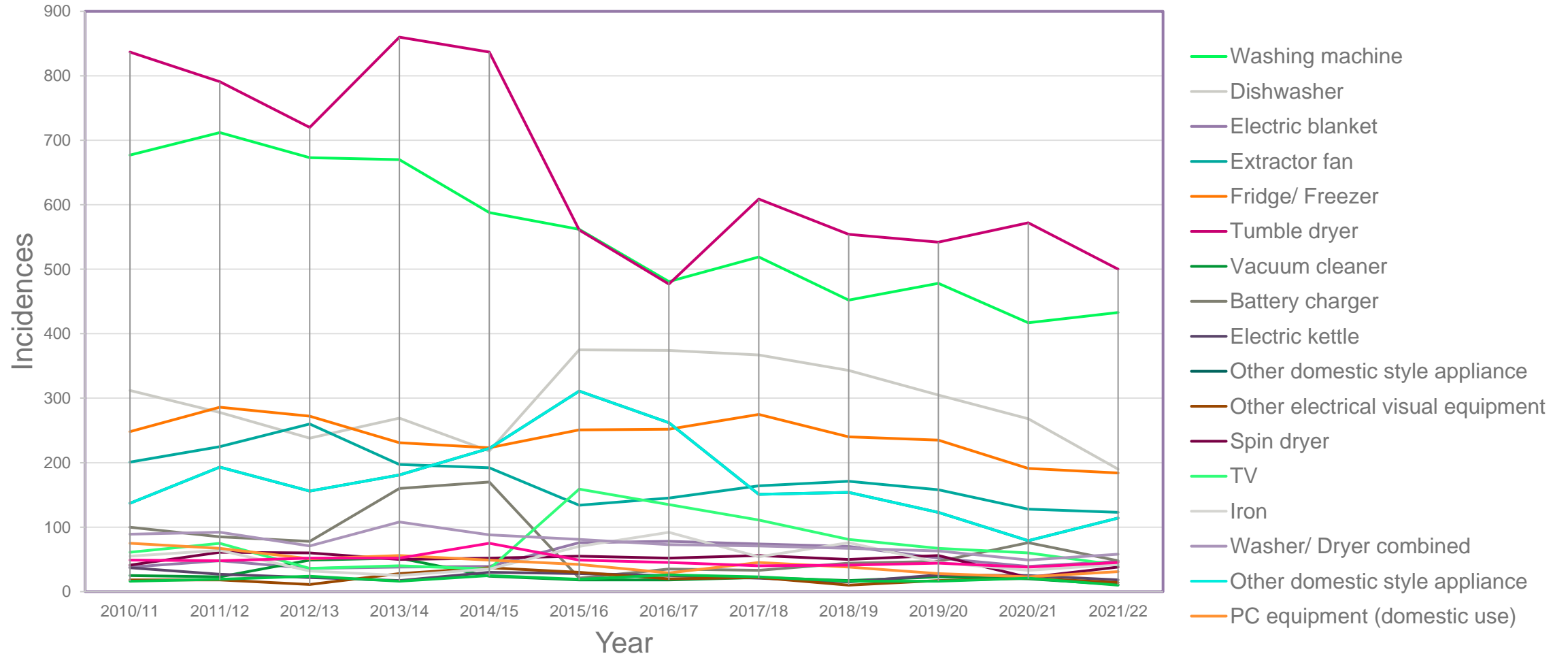

Accidental dwelling Fires (2022-2023)



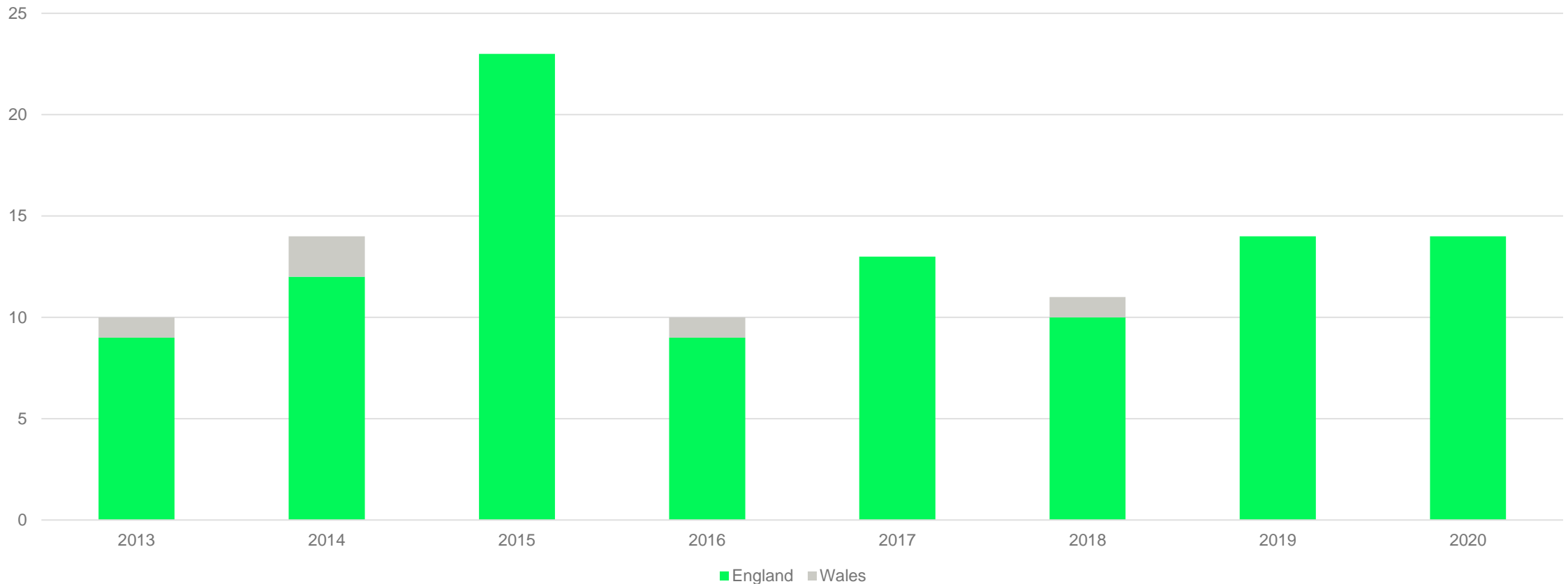
